Resolution 09-17-1952

Councilman Stephensen introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, TO LEASE APPROXIMATELY FIFTY ACRES OF THE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT PROPERTY:

WHEREAS, the City of Rexburg, Idaho, deems it for the best interests of the city to lease approximately 50 acres of the municipal airport property, which acreage is not needed for municipal purposes, and

WHEREAS, said fifty acres are tillable and the rental received therefrom can be applied toward the purchase of the Hollist building now located on said airport, and on other airport expenses,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, as follows:

That the city does hereby declare its intention to lease approximately fifty acres of farming property located at the Municipal Airport in Madison County, Idaho, for a term of five years, on a cash rental basis or a crop share basis, such lease to contain all the customary provisions for the leasing of farming property.

That notice of this resolution be published in two issues of the paper; that such lease be made on the 15th day of October, 1952, at 8 o'clock p.m. of said day at the City Hall in Rexburg, Idaho. The city reserving the right to reject any and all bids.
