## **Resolution 07-06-1955 (2)**

Resolution concerning sale of city property.

Councilman D.D. wilding introduced and moved the adoption of the following:

### **RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the City of Rexburg is the owner of the hereinafter described real property situated in Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, and

WHEREAS, said hereinafter described property has never been used for municipal purposes and is not needed for municipal purposes, and

WHEREAS, it would be to the best interests of the City of Rexburg and the inhabitants thereof, to sell such property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the hereinafter described property be offered for sale for cash to the highest bidder and that notice of intention to sell be given by publication in two issues of the Rexburg Journal, a weekly newspapers printed and published in Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, and that bids be submitted to the City Clerk's office on or before August 3, 1955, at 8 o' clock p.m. and further that the City of Rexburg Reserved the right to reject any and all bids; that said property is situated in Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing 32 ½ feet North of the Southwest corner of Lot 2, block 33 of the Rexburg town site, City of Rexburg, Idaho and running thence North 50 feet; thence East 165 Feet; thence South 50 feet; thence West 165 feet to the point Of beginning.
