Resolution 12-07-1960

Councilman Robert Purrington introduced and moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the City Council and Committee on Sanitation of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, have heretofore made out and certified to the City Council as provided by law an assessment roll for local improvement district No. 5 for the construction and installation of sanitary sewer laterals in said City, and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 1960, said City Council fixed the time and place when and here objections to said assessment roll by property owners in said district would be heard, to-wit: Wednesday, the 7th day of December, 1960, at 8:00 o'clock p.m. of said day at the City Hall in Rexburg, Idaho, and

WHEREAS, notice was duly and regularly given as provided by law by the Clerk of the time to file objections to said assessment roll, and

WHEREAS, certain objections in writing have been made to such assessment roll by property owners in said district, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City Council take additional time in which to investigate and consider said objections to the assessment roll,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this hearing be adjourned as provided by Section 50-2917, Idaho Code, and reconvene the 18th day of January, 1961, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m. of said day at the City Hall at Rexburg, Idaho.
