Resolution 06-07-1961

WHEREAS, the Ricks College expansion program, as shown by the preliminary plans, (the Master Plan not yet being completed) and presented to the City Council by President John L. Clarke, calls for the cooperation of the City of Rexburg, in bringing about such expansion program, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Rexburg, to cooperate in every way possible pertaining to such expansion program, and

WHEREAS, it appears that it will be necessary for the said college to hook on to the City Sewer facilities, and that such facilities are adequate; and

WHEREAS, it further appearing that said college would like 4th South Street made a 100 foot street and improved in order that such street might be an access street, and

WHEREAS, it further appearing that it will be necessary to use the City water system in such expansion program and that the water pressure is not adequate and

WHEREAS, it further appearing that such proposed expansion plan would necessitate the immediate closing of 3rd South street, between 1st East and Center Street, and that South Center Street and 1st and 2nd East Streets should be extended when such expansion program gets underway, and

WHEREAS, it further appearing that the area surrounding the Ricks College property is zoned as A Residential Area, except the E1/2 Block 55 of the City of Rexburg, and E1/2 of Blocks 3 and 13 in the Parker Addition to the City of Rexburg, which portions of said blocks are zoned as a B Residential Area, and it appearing desirous to have such areas zoned as A Residential Areas,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the City of Rexburg will cooperate in every way possible, within its ability to do so, with the Ricks College expansion program;

That the City Council hereby waives all building permit and inspection fees in connection with such expansion program;

That the City will install necessary fire hydrants and give proper fire protection to the Ricks College area;

That the said College has the use of the City sewer facilities at all times;

That the City of Rexburg immediately makes a feasibility study pertaining to the water pressure necessary for such expansion program;

That the City of Rexburg immediately commences work on 4th South Street to make the same a 100 foot street, and improve the same that it might be used as an access street to such college;

That the City when construction is commenced, immediately close 3rd South street, between 1st East and Center Street, and that South Center Street and 1st and 2nd East streets be extended at the necessary time;

That the City use every effort to place the e1/2 Block 55 of the City of Rexburg, and E1/2 of Block 8 and 13 of the parker Addition to the City of Rexburg, in the "A" Residential Area.
