Resolution 09-05-1962

The Mayor presented to the Council the offer and acceptance of the Federal Grant for Sewage Treatment Works. John Porter presented the following resolution and moved it's adoption, seconded by A.H. Brock.

WHEREAS, the City of Rexburg has made application pursuant to Section 6 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act as amended for project financing in the construction of interceptor sewers, life station, exudation pond, including outfall and other necessary appurtenances, and

WHEREAS, the department of Health, Education and Welfare has submitted to the City of Rexburg an offer and acceptance of Federal Grant for Sewage Treatment Work under 33 U.S.C. 466 et seq, and

WHEREAS, the City of Rexburg is desirous of accepting said offer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Rexburg, Idaho, accept said Offer of Federal Grant for Sewage Treatment Works and the Mayor of the City of Rexburg is hereby authorized and directed to sign the acceptance of said offer of Federal Grant for sewage treatment works.
