

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, ESTABLISHING SUPPORT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM TO BEAUTIFY AND LANDSCAPE THE NORTH, SOUTH, AND MAIN STREET INTERCHANGES OF HIGHWAY TWENTY (20)

WHEREAS, the City of Rexburg, wishes to improve and beautify the entrances of our community;

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted entryway improvements as a priority in its 2005 and 2006 strategic plan;

WHEREAS, the City Council has organized the Rexburg Beautification Committee which promotes beautification projects;

WHEREAS, the Beautification Committee has worked diligently to organize and submit a Transportation Enhancement project application to the Idaho Department of Transportation for the beautification of the North, South, and Main Street Interchanges of Highway 20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rexburg City Council, that they support the Entryway Beautification Project. The estimated cost of the project is approximately \$574,375; Which includes a required match of \$74,375, in City matching funds.

This resolution is authorized to be executed by the Mayor, attested to by the City Clerk, and directed to sign the project submittal to Idaho Department of Transportation.
