**RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 10**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AMENDING THE UNIVERSITY VICINITY ON-STREET PARKING MAP AND THE DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL RESIDENTIAL MAP.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to maintain the overall quality of life experienced by its constituents; and

WHEREAS, Campus Vicinity parking and Downtown Commercial Residential parking became permit parking only areas by Ordinance 1028 which allows street designations to be modified or amended by resolution from time to time, and

WHEREAS, in order to effectively manage the parking areas restricted by Ordinance 1028, the areas or restriction need to be adjusted from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the associated map "Exhibit A" for Campus Vicinity on-street parking designates the streets requiring parking permits for "University" and "Residential" designated streets; and

WHEREAS, the associated map "Exhibit B" for Downtown Parking Lots for Downtown Commercial Residential parking designates the allowed parking lots for Commercial Residential over-night parking;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Rexburg, effective September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012, the on-street parking permits designated as University On-Street Parking; Campus Vicinity Residential Parking; and Downtown Commercial Residential Parking shall be designated by the attached on-street parking "Exhibit A and Exhibit B" maps:



Proposed Changes to the maps:

1. College Avenue (1<sup>st</sup> South – 2<sup>nd</sup> South) – U permits
2. 1<sup>st</sup> West (1<sup>st</sup> South – 2<sup>nd</sup> South) – U permits (three homes (2 U – permits each)
3. 2<sup>nd</sup> South (1<sup>st</sup> East – 2<sup>nd</sup> East) – U permits
4. 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> South (2<sup>nd</sup> West – 4<sup>th</sup> West) – U permits
5. 3<sup>rd</sup> West (5<sup>th</sup> South – 6<sup>th</sup> South) – U permits

**Area A: Total: 72 empty parking spaces (Adjacent to the University)**

We counted available parking at the peak hour of 10 a.m., starting on 1<sup>st</sup> West between 5<sup>th</sup> South and 2<sup>nd</sup> South there were only 63 available parking spaces. On 2<sup>nd</sup> South between 1<sup>st</sup> West and Center St. there were 9 available parking spaces, on 2<sup>nd</sup> South between Center Street and 1<sup>st</sup> East there were zero parking spaces, on 1<sup>st</sup> East between 2<sup>nd</sup> South and 3<sup>rd</sup> South following the curve onto 3<sup>rd</sup> South between 1<sup>st</sup> East and 2<sup>nd</sup> East there were zero parking spaces. Area A having a total of 72 parking spaces. We noticed that the northeast side of campus was very congested. The university parking lot across the street from Beehive Federal Credit Union was completely full at this hour (The corner of College Ave and 1<sup>st</sup> South). We noticed a large amount of cars with university parking permits parked along the residential parking on Cornell Ave. between 3<sup>rd</sup> South and 2<sup>nd</sup> South.

**Area B:** *Total: 297 empty parking spaces (Side streets connecting to horse shoe streets adjacent to the University)*

Starting on 2<sup>nd</sup> West between 7<sup>th</sup> South and 5<sup>th</sup> South there were 36 available parking spaces, on 2<sup>nd</sup> West between 5<sup>th</sup> South and 4<sup>th</sup> South 32 parking spaces. The side streets between 2<sup>nd</sup> West and 1<sup>st</sup> West starting with:

- 5<sup>th</sup> South- 25
- 4<sup>th</sup> South- 27
- 3<sup>rd</sup> South- 32
- 2<sup>nd</sup> South- 31

The side streets between 1<sup>st</sup> South and 2<sup>nd</sup> South starting with:

- 1<sup>st</sup> West- 15 (not including the blocked off parking on the eastside because of construction).
- Center St- 20
- College Ave- 58 (completely empty)
- 1<sup>st</sup> East- 21

*Total: 297 empty parking spaces*
