4. New Business:

 - Traffic signal timing should elevate this problem for the time being and will be monitored after implementation.
- On street parking in front of Windsor Manor- Jordan Busby
- 12th and University - Jordan Busby and Ian Zollinger
 - Reviewed the traffic study from the state and found that the area does not have a significant number of accidents warranting Federal Funds to act of the intersection as an emergency in need of immediate action.
- Complaints of excess speeding on 1st North, requests of a stop sign at the intersections.
 - Suggested the tube counters moved to that location along with the . Also, John Millar agreed to monitor the area. Captain Lewis traveled the street the next day and was flagged down by Mr. Smith while he was traveling at a speed under the posted limit. John Millar has traveled the street frequently during the last month and has not seen actions or excessive speeding as reported by Mr. Smith.
