- Mike Ricks contacted Randy Lewis about his concerns on the intersection of Yellowstone Highway and University. He would like to see another painted lane divider for the middle lane for making a left turn onto Yellowstone north bound. This would help the drivers see they can only turn left and not go straight in that lane. It is a little deceiving whether you can go straight or turn because of the position of the light. Another concern is the vehicles are still not stopping at the stop line at the intersection when heading east. The drivers are pulling across the Railroad tracks and then stopping. Could the road be painted with stop here or some other signage?
- Adding a 35 MPH sign at 7th South and University
- Crosswalk on the north side of 1000 South by the Burton School
- The lane change on 1st North, people are speeding past the next person to get ahead before two lanes narrow to one lane.
- Suggestions to decrease speeding in Moriah, Pioneer subdivisions. This area is becoming a speed way for students going from apartments to campus.
