 October 21-November 18. Materials to be picked up must be out at the curb away from your garbage can. Our Street Department will try to pick up materials on your scheduled garbage pick up day, but may be a day after. Please bag or bundle materials as much as possible so they may be picked up by hand. If the City has to use heavy equipment to load trees, branches, etc. you will be notified, and may be charged for equipment use. Limbs & branches should be bundled and cut in 4' to 6' lengths. We will not be able to pick up bagged sod.
