



ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CLOSING OF SALOONS, BREWERIES AND OTHER PLACES WHERE INTOXICATING LIQUORS ARE SOLD, ON SUNDAY; AND PROHIBITING THE SELLING, OR GIVING AWAY OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR ON SUNDAYS, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDINATED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons whether for hire or not, to keep open, or cause to be kept open, within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho, on the first day of the week commonly called Sunday, between the hours of 12 o'clock Saturday night and 12 o'clock Sunday night, any saloon, brewery, or other place of business in which intoxicating, malt, wines, mixed or fermented liquors are kept for sale, to be drank as a beverage.

SECTION II: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to sell, or give away, or cause to be sold or given away within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg; Idaho, on the first day of the week commonly called Sunday, between the hours of 12 o'clock and 12 o'clock Sunday night of each and every week, any intoxicating, malt or vinous, mixed or fermented liquor; provided that drug stores may sell liquors for medical purposes on a prescription of a regularly licensed physician.

SECTION III: Any person violating any part of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ten dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars, together with all costs of conviction and judgment, and in default thereof shall be imprisoned in the Village jail until said fine and costs are paid.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and approval.
