



ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO, INTO A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS, AND DIVIDING THE VILLAGE INTO TWO WARDS TO BE NAMED AND DESIGNATED AS THE FIRST AND SECOND AND CREATING SAID WARDS AND FIXING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR TWO CONCILMEN TO BE ELECTED FROM THE FIRST WARD AND TWO CONCILMEN TO BE ELECTED FROM THE SECOND WARD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – The Village of Rexburg, Idaho, is hereby divided into two wards to be known and designated respectively as the First Ward and Second Ward.

SECTION II – The First Ward is hereby created with the following boundaries, to-wit: Beginning at the N.E. corner of the boundary line of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho, thence west along the north boundary line to where it intersects 1st West St. thence south to the south boundary line of said village, thence east to the S.E. corner of the boundary line of said village, thence north to the N.E. corner of the boundary line of said village to place of beginning.

SECTION III – The Second Ward is hereby created with the following boundaries to-wit: Beginning at the N.E. corner of block No. 6 where 1st West Street intersects the north boundary line of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, thence due west to the N.E. corner of the boundary line of said village, thence due south to the S.W. corner of the boundary line of said village, thence due east to 1st West Street to the S.E. corner of Lot 1 in block 20 of the Parker addition of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho, thence north to the N.E. corner of block No. 6 to the place of beginning.

SECTION IV – That the First Ward of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, shall be entitled to two councilmen to be elected as provided by law.

SECTION V – That the Second Ward of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, shall be entitled to two councilmen to be elected as provided by law.
