



ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ANY PERSON, COMPANY OR CORPORATION TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF , OR CARRY ON, OR OPERATE, ANY SHOOTING GALLERY, MERRY-GO-ROUND, KNIFE BOARD, TRAVELING MENAGERIES, CIRCUS, CARAVAN OR MENAGERY, SIDE SHOWS, EXHIBITIONS, PANORAMAS, STEREOPTICAN, MOVING PICTURES, JUGGLERS, NECROMANCERS, MAGICIANS, WIRE OR ROPE DANCING, EXHIBITIONS, ITINERANT THEATRICAL MINSTREL OR CONCERT EXHIBITIONS WITHOUT FIRST TAKING OUT A LICENSE THEREFORE, AND STATING THE AMOUNT OF SAID LICENSE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL GO INTO EFFECT:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – Every person, company or corporation before engaging in or pursuing any business, vocation or calling hereinafter mentioned shall obtain a license, so to do, and make payment for the same in advance as follows:

For a license for a circus or equestrian, or circus and menagerie for each performance, \$20.00

For a license for each shooting gallery, \$2.00 for the first day, \$1.00 for the second day, and .50 cents for each day thereafter.

For a license for each merry-go-round or whatever description, \$3.00 per day;

For a license for each knife board or similar game of chance, \$1.00 per day;

For a license for a traveling menagerie for each exhibition, \$5.00;

For a license for each side show accompanying a circus, caravan or menagerie, \$1.00 per day;

For a license for each itinerant theatrical, minstrel, or concert company, for each exhibition for pay, \$2.00.

For a license for each panorama, stereopticon, moving pictures, jugglers, necromancers, magicians, wire or rope dancing, or sleight of hand performance, for each exhibition, \$2.00.

Provided that no license shall be required for scientific and literary lectures or entertainments, and providing further, that no license shall be required for concerts and other musical entertainments if given exclusively by any person, company or corporation who are citizens of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho.

SECTION II – Any person, company or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed fifty dollars and costs of conviction and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the village jail and work upon the streets of said village one day for every two dollars of said fine and costs.

SECTION III – This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty day after its passage and approval.
