



**ORDINANCE NO. 33**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON, COMPANY OR CORPORATION ENGAGING IN BUSINESS OR OPERATING, OR RUNNING A PHOTOGRAPH GALLERY, TENT OR CARAVAN, OR ENGAGING IN THE TRANSFER OF GOODS, WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING A LICENSE THEREFORE, AND STATING THE AMOUNT OF SUCH LICENSE, AND STATING THE PERIOD SUCH LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR AND MAKING IT A MISDEMEANOR TO VIOLATE ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL GO INTO EFFECT:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

**SECTION I** – Every person, company or corporation before engaging in or pursuing any business, vocation, or calling hereinafter mentioned, shall obtain a license so to do, and make payment for the same in advance as follows:

For a license for each photograph gallery, tent or caravan, \$5.00 per annum;

For a license for each wagon or other vehicle used with team for the transportation of goods, \$8.00 per annum; provided that nothing herein shall be construed to apply to stages conveying the United States mail, or to private vehicles used by the owners thereof, for the hauling or delivering their own goods.

**SECTION II** – No license as herein provided shall be issued for a less period than one year.

**SECTION III** – Any person, company or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding fifty dollars and cost of conviction, and in default of payment of said fine and costs, shall be confined in the village jail and work upon the streets of said village one day for each two dollars of said fine and costs.

**SECTION IV** – This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and approval.
