



ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 34, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO OWN OR HARBOR ANY DOG FOR MORE THAN TEN DAYS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF REXBURG, WITHOUT FIRST TAKING OUT A LICENSE THEREFORE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 34.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That section 1 of Ordinance #34 be amended to read as follows:

Section 1 – That an annual tax of three dollars is hereby imposed upon the owners or harborers of any dog kept or allowed to remain within the corporate limits of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, and said amount shall be paid for every dog so owned or harbored; provided that the owner or harborer of any bitch shall pay license tax of five dollars per annum for each and every bitch so owned or harbored; and it shall be unlawful for any person owning or harboring any dog within the corporate limits of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, for a period of ten days without first taking out a license therefor. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed twenty five dollars and cost of conviction, and in default of payment of said fine and costs shall be imprisoned in the village jail and work on the streets of the village one day for every two dollars of said fine and costs. Section 1 of Ordinance #34 is hereby repealed.
