ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE, GRANTING TO LORENZO R. THOMAS THE PERPETUAL RIGHT TO BUILD AND MAINTAIN TWO (2) STAIRWAYS ON THE SIDEWALK PORTION OF MAIN STREET, IN FRONT OF A PART OF LOT ONE (1) BLOCK THIRTY-EIGHT (38) OF THE TOWN OF REXBURG SURVEY, VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG:

SECTION I: It is hereby declared to be lawful for, and permission is hereby granted and given to Lorenzo R. Thomas, his heirs, assigns, successors and representatives to construct, and perpetually maintain, as necessary parts of, and appurtenances to the stone block or building to be erected on a part of lot one (1) block thirty-eight (38) of the town of Rexburg survey, two (2) stairways on the front side or end of said building, not exceeding four (4) feet, in width, and leading to the basement of said building, in upon, and through the sidewalk portion of said Main Street, next the front walk of said block or building.

SECTION II: The right to maintain said stairways, and to so occupy said space of said Main Street, is hereby declared to be, and shall be indefeasible and non-forfeitable; provided, nevertheless, that said privilege shall be fully exercised within one (1) year, from the passage and approval of this ordinance; and provided further that the said Lorenzo R. Thomas, his heirs, assigns, successors, and representatives aforesaid, shall effectually safe guard said stairways, with a good and substantial railing or rail hinge and gates, and perpetually maintain the same in good repair.
