ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE OF TAX LEVY UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING THE FIRST TUESDAY IN MAY, 1903, FOR THE USES AND PURPOSES OF SAID VILLAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That a levy of nine mills on the dollar be, and is hereby made on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, taxable according to the laws of the state of Idaho for the fiscal year beginning the first Tuesday of May A.D. 1902 and ending the first Tuesday in May 1903, said tax to be assessed and collected for the uses and purposes of said village.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
