



ORDINANCE NO 4

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING AND CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK, STREET AND ALLEY CROSSING ON MAIN AND FIRST AND SECOND EAST STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of trustees of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho:

SECTION I: That the sidewalk commencing at a point 46 Rods East of the N.E. Corner of Block 37 on the South side of Main Street, thence West 7 blocks to the N.W. Corner of block 42, also the sidewalk on the north side of Main Street, commencing at the southeast corner of block 35, thence west seven blocks to the S.W. corner of block 29, also the sidewalk on the west side of First North Street, commencing at the S.E. Corner of block 33, thence north two blocks to the northeast corner of block 22, also the sidewalk along the east side of Second East Street, commencing at the southwest corner of block 35, thence north to what is known as the lower canal, shall be graded twenty feet wide on Main Street and sixteen feet wide on all other streets with a slope of six inches to the twenty feet, and five inches to the sixteen feet, as per survey and report of John T. Smellie which is hereby approved.

SECTION II: Upon the grade to be built on the south side of Main Street, commencing at the northeast corner of block 37, thence west three and one half blocks to a point of twenty rods west of the northeast corner of block 40, there shall be constructed a walk eight feet wide of either rock or plank at the option of the holders, according to the following specifications:

Rock to be at least four inches thick, dressed square and set together so that the joints shall not be more than one half inch and perfectly smooth on the surface. If of plank to be constructed of six 2H4 stringers bridged every eight feet with 2H4 and covered with 2H3, blind-nailed and to be set in the center of the grade so that it will be even with the surface of the grade on either side of the walk, the street crossing on line of said sidewalk shall be five feet wide, with sleepers not less than eight inches in diameter, rounded so as to be three inches higher in the center than on the outside and set three feet apart across said crossing and covered with 2H4 plank set on edge and securely nailed.

SECTION III: The owner or owners, lessee or lessee=s, occupant or occupants of any house, building or lot fronting on the street along which this line of sidewalk shall be constructed as described in this ordinance shall be at his, her, or their charge and expense, well and sufficiently built according to this ordinance, and shall keep and maintain in good repair the sidewalk in front of any such house, or lots, and in addition thereto, those on the corner of each block shall build and keep in good repair the walk for 16 feet beyond such corner and towards the adjacent cross street.

SECTION IV: It shall be the duty of any person or persons desiring alley crossing across this sidewalk to construct and keep in repair a crossing at least 20 feet wide, and full width of walk in the same manner as provided for in Section 2 for street crossing with the exception that if rock be preferred it shall be at least eight inches thick, also to build and set a culvert in water ditch on said crossing of the size and dimension to be approved by the water master.

SECTION V: It is hereby made the duty of any person or persons that now, or that shall hereafter run any water across said sidewalks to construct and keep in repair a good and substantial culvert made of sufficient capacity for carrying all water so run across, full width of grade and to be covered and set below the survey line of said walks.

SECTION VI: The sidewalks, alleyways and street crossing as here in described shall be completed on or before July 20th 1899 and any person or persons neglecting or refusing to grade and construct such walk or shall be assessed the amount of .25 cents per cubic yard for grading and 15 dollars per lineal rod for walk, to be placed on the county tax roll for collect as provided by law and

provided further that in case said walk shall not be constructed in a workman like manner and as above described the board of trustees are hereby empowered to take up, change or repair the same at the expense of the owner thereof.

SECTION VII: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after its passage and approval.
