ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE FUNDS OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO, BEING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR SAID VILLAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING THE FIRST TUESDAY IN MAY, 1903:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

SECTION I – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Contingent Fund, the sum of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars, for the purpose of paying the salaries of the officers and other employees and the outstanding indebtedness of said village, for the said year.

SECTION II – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Improvement Fund the sum of one thousand five hundred (\$1,500.00) dollars, for the purpose of improving the cemetery and public square of the said village and making such other public improvements as may be ordered by the chairman and board of trustees of said village.

SECTION III – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Road and Bridge Fund the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for the purpose of improving the roads, bridges, highways, and alleys of said village.

SECTION IV – That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists this ordinance shall take effect from an after its passage approval and publication.
