



ORDINANCE NO. 46

**ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLACING A
LICENSE ON BOWLING ALLEYS;**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – There is hereby levied and shall be paid to the village clerk by the owner, proprietor, lessee, keeper, manager, or operator of any bowling alley carried on and operated within the corporate limits of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, a license tax as follows; for a single alley, \$5.00 per quarter, and for a double alley, \$10.00 per quarter.

SECTION II – Every person who is engaged in, commences, conducts, operates or carries on any bowling alley within the corporate limits of the village of Rexburg, Idaho, without first taking out or procuring license as required by Section I of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this ordinance and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than five dollars, and not exceeding fifty dollars.

SECTION III – All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval and publication.
