



**ORDINANCE NO. 54**

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE FEES AND SALARIES OF THE VARIOUS CITY OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, STATE OF IDAHO.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

**SECTION I** – That the salaries and fees of all the officers of the City of Rexburg, be the same elected or appointed, shall be fixed and regulated as follows, to-wit:

The Mayor shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, the sum of \$100.00 per annum.

The City Clerk shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, the sum of \$100.00 per annum, together with the fees allowed by law.

The City Treasurer shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, a sum equal to two per cent on any and all money coming to his hands as treasurer and belonging to the city of Rexburg.

The City Engineer shall have and receive for his services as such officer, the sum of \$4.00 per day, for each days actual services rendered the city.

The City Attorney shall have and receive as full compensation for his services, the sum of \$150.00 per annum.

The City Physician shall have and receive as full compensation for his services, the sum of \$100.0 per annum.

The Street Overseer shall have and receive the sum of \$2.50 per day for and during the time of actual services for the city.

The Chief of Police shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, the sum of \$60.00 per month.

The Salary of councilman shall be and it is hereby fixed to be the sum of \$50.00 per annum, in full as their compensation for such services.

**SECTION II** – The salary of all officers, except the chief of police and street overseer, shall be paid quarterly by a warrant upon the treasurer of said city; but the officers above referred to and excepted from the provisions of said section shall be paid monthly by a warrant upon said city treasurer.

**SECTION III** – All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
