



ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 31, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ANY PERSON, COMPANY OR CORPORATION FROM ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF OR CARRYING ON OR OPERATING ANY SHOOTING GALLERY, MERRY-GO-ROUND, KNIFE BOARD, TRAVELING MENAGERIE, CIRCUS, CARAVAN, OR MENAGERIE, SIDESHOW, EXHIBITION, PANORAMA, STEREOPTICON, MOVING PICTURES, JUGGLERS, NECROMANCERS, MAGICIANS, WIRE OR ROPE DANCING, EXHIBITIONS, ITINERANT THEATRICAL, MINSTREL OR CONCERT EXHIBITIONS, WITHOUT FIRST TAKING OUT A LICENSE THEREFORE, AND STATING THE AMOUNT OF SAID LICENSE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL GO INTO EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG:

SECTION I – That section one of ordinance 31, entitled, "An ordinance to prohibit any person, company, or corporation from engaging in the business of or carrying on or operating any shooting gallery, merry-go-round, knife board, traveling menagerie, sideshows, exhibitions, panoramas, stereopticon or moving pictures, jugglers, necromancers, magicians, wire or rope dancing exhibitions, itinerant theatrical, minstrel concert exhibitions, without first taking out a license therefore, and stating the amount of said license, and providing penalties for the violation of this ordinance and providing when this ordinance shall go into effect, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1 – Every person, company or corporation, before engaging in or pursuing any business, vocation, or calling hereinafter mentioned shall obtain a license so to do, and make payment in advance for the same as follows:

For a license for a circus, or equestrian, or circus and menagerie for each performance \$35.00.

For license for each merry-go-round of whatever description, \$5.00 per day.

For license for each knife board or similar game of chance, \$2.50 per day.

License for each traveling menagerie, for each exhibition, \$5.00.

License for each sideshow accompanying the circus, caravan or menagerie, \$10.00 per day.

License for each itinerant theatrical, minstrel or concert company for each exhibition per pay \$5.00.

License for each panorama, stereopticon, moving pictures, jugglers, necromancers, magicians, wire or rope dancing or sleight of hand performance for each exhibition, \$3.00; provided that no license shall be required for scientific and literary lectures and entertainments; and provided further that no licenses shall be revised to any person, company or corporation to engage in or pursue any business vocation or calling hereinbefore mentioned on the first day of the week commonly called Sunday, between the hours of 12 o'clock Saturday night and 12 o'clock Sunday Night.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
