ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING “AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE FEES AND SALARIES OF THE VARIOUS CITY OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, STATE OF IDAHO;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG;

SECTION I – That section one of ordinance No. 54, entitled “An ordinance fixing the fees and salaries of the various city officers of the city of Rexburg, State of Idaho”, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1 – That the salaries and fees of all the officers of the City of Rexburg, be the same elected or appointed shall be fixed and regulated as follows, to-wit:

The City Clerk shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, the sum of \$100 per annum, together with the fees allowed by law.

The City Treasurer shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, a sum equal to two percent on any and all money coming to his hands as Treasurer and belonging to the city of Rexburg.

The City Engineer shall have and receive for his services as such officer the sum of \$4.00 per day for each day of actual services rendered the city.

The City Attorney shall have and receive as full compensation for his services the sum of \$150 per annum.

The Street Overseer shall have and receive the sum of \$2.50 per day and during the rime of actual service for the city.

The Chief of Police shall have and receive as full compensation for his services ads such officer, the sum of \$60 per month.

WHEREAS, an emergency existing, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication by law.
