



ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO NUISANCES, AND PROHIBITING THE DEPOSITING OF REFUSE, GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND FILTH, OR ANY LOOSE BARBED WIRE IN THE STREETS OR ALLEYS, OR UPON ANY VACANT LOT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AND RELATING TO, AND PROHIBITING THE ERECTION AND MAINTAINING OF ANY SLAUGHTER HOUSE WITHIN ONE-FOURTH OF A MILE OF ANY DWELLING HOUSE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID VILLAGE, AND RELATING TO, AND PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF ANY FILTHY PIG PENS, STABLES, OR DECAYING PILES OF MANURE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID VILLAGE, AND PROVIDING FOR A NOTICE OF THREE DAYS TO BE GIVEN BY THE ROAD OVERSEER TO THE OFFENDING PARTY, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE .

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho:

SECTION I: That it shall be, and is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to deposit any filth, refuse, garbage or rubbish in, or upon the streets or alleys, or upon any vacant lot or lots, within the Corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho.

SECTION II: That it shall be, and is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to erect and maintain any slaughter house within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg which shall be within one quarter of a mile of any dwelling house within the corporate limits of said village.

SECTION III: That it shall be, and is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to erect and maintain, or keep any filthy pig pen or stables, or keep, or permit to be kept any pile, or piles of decaying manure within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg.

SECTION IV: That it shall be, and is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to deposit, or cause to be deposited upon the streets or alleys of the Village of Rexburg, any loose barbed wire, or for any person or persons who may own, or have in their care any fence of which barbed wire is a part thereof, to allow said barbed wire fence to become loose from the fence, to allow said barbed wire fence to become loose from the fence posts and lay on the ground, in any of the streets or alleyways of the Village of Rexburg.

SECTION V: That it shall be, and is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to flood the streets or sidewalks of the Village of Rexburg with water; or to allow any water to overflow or break from their own private ditches into the streets or sidewalks of the Village of Rexburg; or to overflow or break from the confines or limits of the lot, lots, or land that they may be using water on for irrigating or other purposes onto any of the sidewalks or streets of the Village of Rexburg.

SECTION VI: That any filth, refuse, garbage or rubbish found, or being upon any vacant or occupied lot, or in any street or alley within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho; or the erection and maintaining of any slaughter house within the corporate limits of said village which shall be within one quarter of a mile of any dwelling house within the corporate limits of said village; or the erection, or maintaining, or keeping any filthy pig pen, or stables, or keeping or permitting to be kept any pile or piles of decaying manure; or any loose barbed wire; or loose barbed wire fences; or water overflowing the banks of private irrigating ditches, or overflowing the confines of the lot, lots, or land, upon which it is used onto any of the streets or sidewalks within the

corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

SECTION VII: It shall be, and is hereby declared to be the duty of the Village Road Overseer to inspect all lots, streets and alleys within the corporate limits of said Village, and to give three days notice to such person or persons committing, maintaining, or permitting a public nuisance aforesaid, of the existence of such public nuisance, and command such person or persons to remove, or abate the same within three days from date of such notice.

SECTION VIII: Any person, or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed fifty dollars and costs of conviction, and upon failure of the payment of the fine and costs imposed, shall be imprisoned in the village jail until said fine and costs are paid, at the rate of one day for every two dollars of such fine and costs imposed, and may be compelled to work upon streets of the Village of Rexburg at the rate of one day for every two dollars of such fine and costs imposed.

SECTION IX: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and approval.
