ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE FUNDS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO; BEING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE SAID CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING THE FIRST TUESDAY IN MAY, 1904.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the contingent fund, the sum of one thousand six hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,650.00) for the purpose of paying the salaries of the officers and other employees and the outstanding indebtedness of said city, for the said year.

SECTION II – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Improvement Fund, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), for the purpose of improving the public square of said city, and making such other public improvements, as may be ordered by the mayor and council of said city, and for the purpose of purchasing real estate for the city.

SECTION III – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Road and Bridge Fund the sum of one thousand dollars, (\$1,000.00) for the purpose of improving the roads, bridges, highways and alleys of said city.

SECTION IV – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Ditch Fund the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the purpose of cleaning and keeping in repair the canals and laterals of the city and for head gates, culverts, weirs, etc.

SECTION V – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Cemetery Fund the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the purpose of cleaning out ditches, laying of sidewalks, planting trees, repairing fences, and otherwise improving the cemetery.

SECTION VI – That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Electric Light Fund, the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) for the purpose of maintaining arc lights upon the streets of the city and for lighting other city buildings and offices.

SECTION VII – That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
