



ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK CROSSINGS IN THE CITY OF REXBURG AND PROHIBITING THE CROSSING BY HORSE, MULE, OR ANY OTHER BEAST OF BURDEN OR OTHER ANIMAL OF ANY SUCH SIDEWALK, AT ANY OTHER POINT THAN SUCH CROSSING AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDINANED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That all sidewalk crossing on plank sidewalks leading to private lanes and alleys or buildings in the City of Rexburg shall be built of plank not less than two by three inches, placed on edge, and spiked together with twenty penny common nails, every eighteen inches. Said crossings shall be not less than ten feet long, and laid on 2 x 4 inch stringers, two feet from centers, and toe nailed to said stringers. All crossings to extend the width of the plank sidewalk, and be properly graded on each side with good gravel. On any sidewalk in the City of Rexburg, not built of plank crossings leading to private lanes, alleys or buildings shall be graded with good gravel to a depth of at least six inches, and for a width of six feet and extend from outside of culvert to lot line.

SECTION II: All persons are hereby prohibited from leading, driving or riding any horse, mule or other beast of burden or any other animal upon any sidewalk within the corporate limits of the City of Rexburg, unless it be upon a proper crossing herein provided. And the owner of any such sidewalks is prohibited from permitting any person to lead, drive or ride any horse, mule, or other beast of burden or other such animal upon any such sidewalk.

SECTION III: Any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined for each offence in a sum not to exceed one hundred dollars.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby appealed.

WHEREAS, an emergency existing, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as by law provided.
