**ORDINANCE NO. 77**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 75 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS" WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS THEREOF.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG.

**SECTION I.** That Section 9 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section IX. Any and all persons applying for and obtaining a license under the provisions of this ordinance, shall be permitted to maintain blinds at the doors and windows, of the building in which said liquors are licensed to be sold not to exceed, a height of five and a half feet from the grade of sidewalk abutting such property; and shall remove same entirely at midnight on Saturday evening, and keep them removed until midnight Sunday evening. They shall also keep all doors of the building in which said liquors are licensed to be sold, unlocked and easy of access by the Chief of Police or other peace officer during business hours.

**SECTION II.** All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

An emergency existing this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
