ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING AND ESTABLISHING THE WIDTH OF FIRST WEST STREET AND PROVIDING FOR THE LOCATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CITY MONUMENT ON SAID STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That the width of First West Street is hereby fixed and established at 96 feet and 6 inches, and that the official plat of the City of Rexburg adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho at its regular session held July 8, 1901, and filed for record July 9, 1901, with the Auditor an Records of Fremont County Idaho on paid July 9, 1901, be amended to show First West Street to be of the width prescribed herein, to-wit: 96 feet and 6 inches and is so amended by the terms of this ordinance.

SECTION II – That the City Engineer is hereby authorized and instructed to locate the chief city monument on said First West Street at a point 20 feet north of the northwest corner of Lot two (2) block thirty nine (39) as per recorded plat of the City of Rexburg and that all measurements for the location and determination of any lot block street or alley in said city of Rexburg shall be determined from said chief city monuments which is by this ordinance declared to be the official starting point to determine the meters and bounds of all lots and parts of lots surveyed and platted and shown on the recorded plat of the city of Rexburg.

SECTION III – All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
