



ORDINANCE NO 9

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DRIVING OF STOCK INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, FREMONT COUNTY IDAHO, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, FREMONT COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons to drive stock of any kind off the range over which said persons or persons have no control, or without the permission of the owner, into the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg for any purpose whatsoever, unless the said person or persons, without unnecessary delay return said stock so driven in the direction from which said person or persons brought them, beyond the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg.

SECTION II: Any person or persons violating any provisions of this ordinance shall, on conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined in any sum not to exceed twenty dollars and cost of prosecution. In default of the payment of such judgment the defendant shall be imprisoned in the Village jail and work upon the streets of the Village of Rexburg one day for every two dollars of said fine and costs.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and approval.
