



**ORDINANCE NO. 143**

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF RAISING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF REXBURG FROM PERSONS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF HIRING OUT AND RUNNING AUTOMOBILES FOR PROFIT, PROVIDING A LICENSE TAX THEREFORE, AND A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF THE SAME WITHIN THE CITY OF REXBURG.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

**SECTION I:** That hereafter every person, firm, corporation or company engaging in the business of letting, hiring or running automobiles, within the corporate limits of the City of Rexburg for the carrying of passengers for hire, shall, before engaging in such business take out a license therefore, and shall pay therefore, in advanced, a license fee of \$3.00 for each automobile, per quarter, to the treasurer of the city, and upon payment of the same the clerk shall issue to such person, firm, or corporation a license permitting him or them to engage in such business.

**SECTION II:** For a failure to make payment and take out a license as in this section one provided each and every person, firm, corporation engaging in such business shall be found guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than \$50.00 and not to exceed \$100.00, and cost, for each and every offense.

**SECTION III:** This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval and publication as required by law.
