ORDINANCE NO. 151

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE REVENUE OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, STATE OF IDAHO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING WITH THE FIRST THURSDAY IN MAY 1912.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, STATE OF IDAHO:

SECTION I: That all moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots be and the same is hereby apportioned to the Cemetery Fund.

That all money received from the Road Poll tax be and the same is hereby apportioned to the Road and Bridge Fund.

That all moneys received from the annual tax levy on city property, be, and hereby is apportioned as follows:

Fifty percent to the Road and Bridge Fund and Fifty percent to the General Expense Fund.

That all moneys received from the assessment of the City Canal and the same is hereby apportioned to the Ditch Fund.

That all moneys received from the city Water Works be and the same is hereby apportioned to the Water Works Fund.

That all moneys received from all other sources not otherwise apportioned be and the same is hereby apportioned to the General Expense Fund.
