



ORDINANCE NO. 154

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DESTRUCTION OR INJURY OF ANY LAMP POST, WIRE OR OTHER FIXTURE THEREOF; PROHIBITING THE TYING AND LATCHING OF ANY HORSE, MULE, OR OTHER ANIMALS TO ANY LAMP POST IN ANY STREET, ALLEY, OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACE IN THE CITY OF REXBURG; DECLARING ANY SUCH ACT TO BE A MISDEMEANOR AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to willfully injure, damage or destroy any lamp post, globe, wire or other fixture connected with, or belonging to, any lamp, lamp post, or wire in any street, alley, or other public place in the City of Rexburg, or to tie, latch or fasten any horse, mule or other animal to any such lamp post, or to any part on fixture thereof.

SECTION II: A violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, and any person guilty thereof shall, on correction, be punished by any fine in any sum not to exceed twenty-five dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail at hard labor for not to exceed ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
