ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME IN WHICH CITY WATER SHALL BE USED FOR SPRINKLING PURPOSES, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG;

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm, association, company, or corporation within the City of Rexburg, to use a hose for sprinkling lawns, walks, or gardens, or to use water from the City Water system for any purpose, except for domestic purposes, between the hours of nine o'clock a.m. and six o'clock p.m., and between the hours of nine o'clock p.m. and five o'clock a.m.

SECTION II: Any person, persons, firm, company, corporation or association found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$25.00 for each and every offence so committed.
