



**ORDINANCE NO. 172A**

**ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR, AND LEVYING A TAX ASSESSMENT ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, FOR GENERAL AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES, A SPECIAL TAX ASSESSMENT FOR THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING WARRANT INDEBTEDNESS, A SPECIAL TAX ASSESSMENT TO PAY INTEREST ON BONDS, AND FIXING THE RATE ON SUCH BONDS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG,

**SECTION I:** That there be, and there is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, for the year 1913 a tax assessment of 10 mills on the dollar of the value thereof for the general and incidental expenses of the said city for the fiscal year ending the first Tuesday of May 1914; and a special tax of 3 mills on the dollar of such assessed valuation for the payment of interest on outstanding bonds and to provide a sinking fund. The moneys collected from these several assessments shall be converted into the funds for the purposes named.

**SECTION II:** That said tax assessment and special tax shall be certified by the City Clerk to the Collecting of Taxes of Fremont County, and be entered on the tax rolls of said county and be collected as State and County taxes are collected for the year 1913.
