**ORDINANCE NO. 173A**

**ANNUAL APPROPRIATING AND APPORTIONING THE REVENUES  
OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, TO THE SEVERAL FUNDS  
ENTITLED THERETO.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG.

**SECTION I:** That all moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots during the year 1913 be and the same are hereby appropriated to the cemetery fund.

That all moneys received from the Road Tax be and the same is hereby appropriated to the Road and Bridge Fund.

That all moneys received from the assessment of City Canal be and the same is hereby appropriated to the Ditch Fund.

That all moneys received from the city water works be and the same is hereby appropriated to the Water Works Funds.

That all moneys received from the general property assessment on property within the corporate limits of the city be, and the same is hereby apportioned to the following funds, to-wit;

Fifty per cent thereof to the general expense fund and Fifty per cent to the Road and Bridge Fund;

That all moneys received from special tax assessment for the redemption of outstanding warrants be and the same is hereby appropriated to the Warrant redemption fund.

That all moneys received from special assessment tax for the payment of interest on bonds and the creation of sinking fund be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying such interest on bonds outstanding and any surplus covered into the Sinking Fund.
