**ORDINANCE NO. 178**

**ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL**

**AN ORDINANCE FOR AND LEVYING A TAX ASSESSMENT ON ALL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR GENERAL AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES, A SPECIAL TAX ASSESSMENT TO PAY INTEREST ON BONDS, AND PROVIDE A SINKING FUND AND FIXING THE RATES OF SUCH TAXES.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG;

**SECTION I:** That there be and is hereby levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the city of Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, for the year 1914 a tax assessment of eight mills on the dollar of the assessed value thereof for the general and incidental expenses of the said city for the fiscal year ending the first Tuesday of May, 1915; and a special tax assessment of two mills on the dollar of such assessed valuation for the payment of interest on outstanding bonds and to provide a sinking fund. The moneys collected from these several assessments shall be converted into funds for the purpose named.

**SECTION II:** That said tax assessment and special tax assessment shall be certified by the City Clerk to the collector of taxes of Madison County and be entered on the tax rolls of said county and collected as state and county taxes are collected for the year 1914.

**SECTION III:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
