



ORDINANCE NO. 179

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL

AN ORDINANCE APPORTIONING AND APPROPRIATING THE REVENUES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, TO THE SEVERAL FUNDS ENTITLED THERETO;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG;

SECTION I: That all moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots during the year 1914 be, and the same are hereby appropriated to the cemetery fund.

That all money received from road poll tax be and the same are hereby appropriated to the road and bridge fund.

That all moneys received from the assessment of the City Canal be and the same are hereby appropriated to the ditch fund.

That all moneys received from the city water works be and the same is hereby appropriated to the water works fund.

That all moneys received from the general property tax assessment on property within the corporate limits of the city be and the same are hereby apportioned and appropriated to the following funds, to-wit: Fifty percent to the general expense fund and fifty percent to the road and bridge fund.

That all money received from the special tax assessment for the payment of interest on bonds and the creation of a sinking fund be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying such interest on bonds outstanding.

That all moneys received from all other sources not otherwise apportioned or appropriated be and the same are hereby appropriated to the general expense fund.

SECTION II: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
