



ORDINANCE NO. 190

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THE TIME, PLACE AND MANNER OF HOLDING REGULAR AND SPECIAL MEETINGS, AND THE METHOD OF CALLING SPECIAL MEETINGS, AND DECLARING EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG:

SECTION I: That the regular meetings of the city council of the City of Rexburg shall convene and be held in the city hall in said city of the hour of 8 o'clock p.m. of the first and third Wednesdays of each month, and such regular meetings may, by resolution of the council, adjourn from time to time as the business of the city may, in the discretion of the council, require.

SECTION II: That special meetings of the City Council may be called at any time by the Mayor or by three members of the Council, provided, that such special meeting shall be called by serving notice at least twelve hours prior to the time set for holding of the same, upon the members of the council, and such call shall contain a statement of the object of such special meetings.

SECTION III: Whereas an emergency exists therefor this ordinance shall be force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
