



ORDINANCE NO. 194

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OWNERS OF DOMESTIC FOWLS FROM ALLOWING THE SAME TO TRESPASS UPON THE PREMISES BELONGING TO OTHER, WITHIN THE CITY OF REXBURG. MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO PERMIT DOMESTIC FOWLS TO RUN AT LARGE. DURING THE SEASON BETWEEN THE FIRST DAY OF APRIL AND THE FIRST DAY OF OCTOBER OF EACH YEAR; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any person owning or having in his possession any chicken, chickens, duck, ducks, goose, geese, turkey, turkeys, or other domestic fowl, within the city of Rexburg, to willfully or negligently permit the same to run at large or trespass upon the premises belonging to another or to stray beyond the boundaries or the yard or premises belonging to or in control of the owner of such chicken, chickens, ducks, ducks, goose, geese, turkey, turkeys or other domestic fowl.

SECTION II: It shall be the duty of every owner or possessor of any domestic fowl mentioned in Section one hereof, to confine the same within the yard or premises owned or occupied by such person during the season commencing with the first day of April and ending with the first day of October of each and every year.

SECTION III: Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in a sum not exceeding the sum of \$25.00, and costs of court.

Whereas an emergency exists therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication.
