



ORDINANCE NO. 195

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 34 AND 35 OF CHAPTER X OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I: That Section 34 of the Revised Ordinances, Chapter X of the City of Rexburg, be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 34 – That hereafter, any person, company or corporation desiring to erect any building within the area of the bounds described as fire limits, shall make application to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rexburg for a permit before commencing the construction thereof, by filing with the City Clerk such application at least twenty-four hours prior to any regular meeting of the City Council, and upon the issuance of any such permit by the Mayor and City Council a fee of \$3.00 shall be paid to the City Clerk. Said application shall give the name or names of the person, company or corporation intending to erect or construct such building, together with the plans, kind of material to be used in the construction, approximate cost of construction, name of the contractor, date of commencement of work and time of completion.

SECTION II: That Section 35, Chapter X of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Rexburg be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 35 – Any person, company or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction shall pay a fine of not to exceed the sum of \$100.00 or imprisonment in the City jail not exceeding 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication, an emergency existing therefor.
