



ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY CANAL AND DITCHES, LEVYING ASSESSMENTS ON EACH SHARE OF STOCK FOR THE YEAR 1916, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG;

SECTION I: There is hereby levied an assessment of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) on each share of the capital stock of the city canal to be paid in lawful money of the United States of America, to the Secretary of said canal at his office in the City Hall, in the City of Rexburg, county of Madison, State of Idaho.

SECTION II: Such assessment may be due and payable on or before the 10th day of July, 1916, and shall become delinquent and subject to sale after the 10th day of July, 1916, and all delinquent stockholders or water users of the waters of the city canal shall be prohibited from using the same after the assessment shall become delinquent and during such time as said assessment shall remain delinquent.

SECTION III: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: Whereas an emergency exists, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
