ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, AND THE TIME OF PAYMENT THEREOF, OF THE MAYOR, COUNCILMEN AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF REXBURG.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That the salaries of the mayor, councilmen and city clerk of the city of Rexburg shall be and are fixed as follows;

The annual salary of the Mayor shall be \$400.

The annual salary of each Councilman shall be \$200.

The annual salary of the City Clerk shall be \$1200.

Such salaries shall be payable in twelve equal installments, one installment at the end of each month beginning with the month of May, 1919.

SECTION II – All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III – This ordinance, after its passage, approval and due publication, shall take effect on the first Tuesday of May 1919,
