ORDINANCE NO. 222

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATIONS AND THE TIME OF THE PAYMENT THEREOF OF CERTAIN APPOINTIVE CITY OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG VIZ: CITY TREASURER, CITY ATTORNEY, POLICE JUDGE, CHIEF OF POLICE, SUPERINTENDANT OF WATER WORKS, OVERSEER OF STREETS AND WATER MASTER COMBINED, CITY ENGINEER AND CITY PHYSICIAN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That the Salary, and compensation and the time of payment thereof of the following named appointive city officers is fixed as follows:

City Treasurer – Two Hundred Dollars per annum, payable quarterly, at the end of each quarter.

City Attorney – Six Hundred Dollars per annum, payable quarterly, at the end of each quarter.

Police Judge - Three Hundred Dollars per annum, payable monthly at the end of each month.

Chief of Police – Fifteen Hundred Dollars per annum, payable monthly at the end of each month.

Superintendent of Waterworks – Fifteen Hundred Dollars per annum payable monthly at the end of each month.

Overseer of Streets and Water-master combined – Thirteen Hundred and Twenty Dollars per annum, payable monthly at the end of each month, for time of service rendered the city.

City Physician – Two Hundred Forty Dollars per annum, payable quarterly at the end of each quarter.

City Engineer – Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents per day for and during the time of actual service rendered the city, payable as ordered by the mayor and council.

SECTION II – This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
