



ORDINANCE NO. 223

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 60, CHAPTER 9, PART 1, OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 142 OF SAME CITY, PROVIDING FOR THE SEIZING, IMPOUNDING, RETENTION, SALE, FUNDING AND CARE OF ANIMALS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I: That Section 60, Chapter 9, Part 1, of the revised ordinance number 142 be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 60 – That there shall be collected by the City Pound-keeper upon each animal so seized and impounded the following fees: for the seizure and impounding of each animal under the provisions of this ordinance the sum of three dollars per head, for each day or part of days retention and feeding the sum of One Dollar per head, for advertising each animal twice seventy-five cents, for each auction sale seventy-five cents per head, for branding each animal seventy-five cents per head. All animals taken up and impounded shall be properly cared for and supplied with sufficient food and water where so confined.

SECTION II: All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
