



ORDINANCE NO. 274

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 273 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, COUNTY OF MADISON, STATE OF IDAHO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DECREASING THE TAX LEVY ON PROPERTY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID CITY FOR THE YEAR 1921.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, State of Idaho on the 20th of July, 1921 passed and approved Ordinance No. 273 whereby there was levied on the property of said City for the fiscal year of 1921 taxes amounting to eighteen mills on the dollar, and whereas,

Subsequent to the passage of said Ordinance, the State Board of Equalization of the State of Idaho increased the valuation of the taxable property in said City, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, State of Idaho;

SECTION I: That Section II of Ordinance No. 273 be amended and made to read as follows:

SECTION II: That there is hereby levied on the taxable property in the City of Rexburg, in the State of Idaho for the fiscal year 1921 for the purpose of securing revenue for the several funds, taxes as follows:

General levy 8 mills on the dollar,

Levy for Interest on City Bonds and Sinking Fund, 5 mills on the dollar on the assessed valuation of said property for the year 1921, and the Treasurer of the City of Rexburg I hereby authorized and directed to apportion all money received on account of said taxes to the said funds upon said basis.

SECTION III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: Whereas an emergency exists this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and due publication as required by law.
