



**ORDINANCE NO. 326**

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING DRIVERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF REXBURG TO HAVE IN THEIR POSSESSION AT THE TIME OF DRIVING SAID VEHICLE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED BY THE STATE OF IDAHO; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES OF VIOLATION.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY the City of Rexburg, Idaho:

**SECTION I:** It shall be unlawful for any person, except those expressly exempt by the laws of the State of Idaho, to drive any motor vehicle upon the streets or highways of the City of Rexburg unless such person has a valid license as an operator or chauffeur issued in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho.

**SECTION II:** Each licensee shall have his operator's or chauffeur's license in his possession at all time when operating a motor vehicle within the City of Rexburg and shall display upon demand of the police officers of the City or any state police officer such license; however, no person charged with violation this section shall be convicted if he produces in court and operator's or chauffeur's license theretofore issued by the State of Idaho to him and valid at the time of his arrest.

**SECTION III:** Each person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than 30 days, or both.
