**ORDINANCE NO. 332**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING REASONABLY PREVENTABLE RADIO INTERFERENCE A NUISANCE; REQUIRING ALL ELECTRICAL AND OTHER DEVICES WHICH CAUSE RADIO INTERFERENCE TO BE SO EQUIPPED WHERE POSSIBLE WITH DEVICES TO ELIMINATE INTERFERENCE, MAKING SUCH PREVENTABLE INTERFERENCE A MISDEMEANOR AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY the City of Rexburg, Idaho:

That all radio interference which can be reasonably prevented is hereby declared a nuisance. That all electrical apparatus or devices, or any other apparatus or devices, which causes radio interference and which can be equipped with devices which eliminate radio interference, be immediately equipped with said devices so as not to interfere with radio reception. That any person violation this ordinance is guilty of misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) and not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR, this 21st day of April, 1937.
