ORDINANCE NO. 350

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE "ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, FOR THE YEAR 1944; LEVING TAXES FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES OF SAID CITY AND FOR INTEREST ON THE BONDED INDEBTEDNESS AND FOR SINKING FUND: AND APPROPRIATING TO THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS, OFFICES AND FUNDS OF SAID CITY GOVERNMENT SUCH SUMS AS MAY BE NECESSARY, OR DEEMED NECESSARY, BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL, TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES FOR SAID CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1944.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

SECTION I: This ordinance, shall be and is hereby termed "The Annual Appropriation Bill of the City of Rexburg, Idaho for the fiscal year 1944.

SECTION II: There is hereby levied upon all the taxable property within the limits of the City of Rexburg, and subject to taxation for city purposes, in am for the year 1944, taxes for the several purposes of said city government at the rate following:

For General Revenue purposes ten (10) mills on each Dollar of assessed valuation

For interest on outstanding bonds of the city and for sinking fund to pay the maturity installments of each bond, fifteen (15) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

SECTION III: The City Clem is hereby empowered and directed to certify the following levies to the proper officers of Madison County, Idaho, for entry upon the tax rolls of said county for collection in the manner provided by law.

SECTION IV: The City Treasurer is hereby empowered arid directed to apportion the moneys received on account of taxes hereby levied, and from .all other purposes to the several funds for which said levies are made and to which moneys are appropriated as in this ordinance provided.

SECTION V: The revenue of the City of Rexburg for the fiscal year 1944 from all sources received are hereby appropriated to the several funds and purposes which are hereby declared to be necessary for such purposes as shown by the budget of the city heretofore adopted for said fiscal year, respectively as follows: -

A. ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENT - GENERAL EXPENSE FUND: From moneys received on account of taxes levied, and other available sources, there is hereby appropriated to the General Fund Expense Administrative Department and Sundries, the sum of \$8,094.00.

B. WATER DEPARWENT - From sources derived from the water works system of the city during the fiscal year 1944 and moneys now on hand in the waterworks fund, and other revenues available there is hereby appropriated the amount necessary to defray the expenses of operation and maintenance of said system during the fiscal year 1944, and for such revenues and f or said purposes there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$6,850.00.

C. STREET DEPARTMENT - From moneys received on account of taxes levied thereof and other revenues available, there is hereby appropriated to the Streets Department of the City of Rexburg for maintenance and improvements for public streets, alleys, parks and public grounds the sum of \$23,050.00. This also includes Street Lighting.

D. POLICE DEPARTMENT - From moneys received on account of taxes thereof and other sources available, there is hereby appropriated to the Police Department for the payment of salaries and other necessary expenses the sum of \$2,950.00.

E. FIRE DEPARTMENT - From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefor, and other revenues there is hereby appropriated to the Fire Department of the said City of Rexburg for the paying of salaries and other expenses of operation and maintenance the sum of \$5,600.00.

F. IRRIGATION DEPARTMENT - All moneys received from and on account of the Irrigation system of the City of Rexburg, and the distribution of water thereby to the inhabitants of The city, are hereby appropriated to the City Ditch Fund for the payment of salaries, wages and other necessary expenses of operation and maintenance of said irrigation system, there is hereby appropriated to the city ditch fund the sum of \$2,800.00.

G. INTEREST AND SINKING FUND - From moneys received on account of taxes levied and other revenues available for said purposes there is hereby appropriated for the payment of interest and outstanding general obligation bonds of said city and payment of maturing installments on such bonded indebtedness the sum of \$16,129.00.

H. All revenues of the City of Rexburg received during the fiscal year 1944 not hereby otherwise appropriated, are hereby apportioned to the General Fund.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it is passed, approved and due publication as required by law.
