



ORDINANCE NO. 361

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE STREET OR ALLEY IN LOT 2, BLOCK 34 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, Rulon H. Lewis, Blayne D. Bird, Thell Bunnell, Julia Ricks, Ross Parkinson Ella G. Harriman, Mrs. J.W. Webster, and D.W. Stowell have requested the City Council to vacate and close a certain portion of the street or alley in lot 2, Block 34 or the City of Rexburg, Idaho, for the sole and exclusive use of the adjacent real estate owners as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That a certain portion of the street or alley in Lot 2, Block 34 of the City of Rexburg and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point 5 rods West of the Northeast corner of Lot 2, Block 34 of the City Rexburg, as per recorded plat thereof, and running thence south 10 rods, thence West two rods, thence North 10 rods, thence East two rods to the place of beginning. Be, and is hereby vacated and closed for the sole and exclusive use of the owners of the adjacent real estate, as provided by the statutes of the state of Idaho, and the Mayor and City Clerk are directed to execute to the said owners in the name of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, quit claim deeds to that portion of said street or alley as provided by law.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take affect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and due publication, as provided by law.
