ORDINANCE NO. 446

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING A PORTION OF FOURTH EAST STREET BETWEEN SECOND SOUTH STREET AND THIRD SOUTH STREET FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE ON THE WEST AND EAST OF SAID FOURTH EAST STREET BETWEEN SECOND SOUTH STREET AND THIRD SOUTH STREET IN THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, Madison County School District No. A 321, Wells Grover, and Jack Randall, have requested the City Council to vacate and close 19.5 feet on the West side of Fourth East Street between Second south Street and Third South Street, and 19.5 feet on the East side of said Fourth East Street between Second South Street and Third South Street in the City of Rexburg, Idaho, for the sole and exclusive use of the owners on the East and West side of said Fourth East Street between Second South and Third South, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the vacating and closing of a portion of said street is particularly requested by said school district as a safety measure and protection for students attending the Lincoln School adjacent to Fourth East Street and between Second and Third South Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That 19.5 feet on the West side of Fourth East Street between Second South and Third South in the City of Rexburg, Idaho, and 19.5 feet on the East side of Fourth East Street between Second South Street and Third South Street in Rexburg, Idaho, be, and the same is hereby vacated and closed for the sole and exclusive use of the owners of the adjacent real estate on the East and the West side of said street as provided by the statutes of the State of Idaho, and the Mayor and City Clerk are directed to execute to said owners in the name of the City of Rexburg, Quit Claim Deeds to the portions of said street so vacated and closed as provided by law.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and due publication as provided by law.
